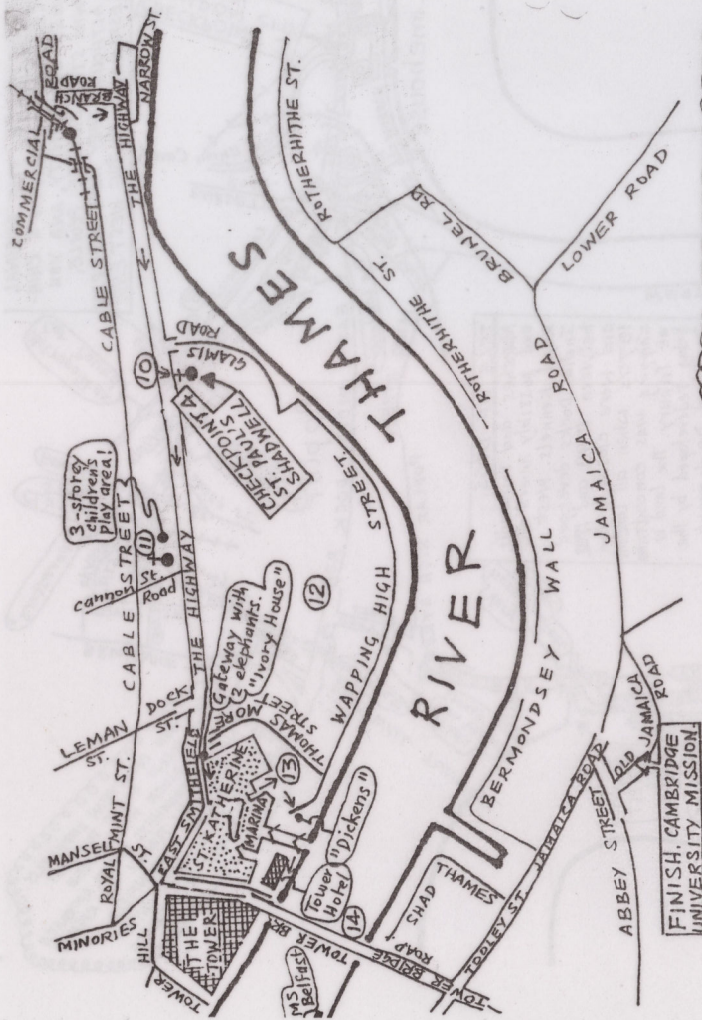




- ① Greenwich Foot-tunnel. Reached by lift or spiral stair-case. Opened in 1902; 1,217 feet long and 62 feet below the river. It is lined with over 200,000 white tiles.
- ② In the Island Gardens is a pleasant refreshment kiosk. Do not miss the splendid view of the Royal Naval College, the Cutty Sark and 'The Trafalgar' Inn where the famous white-bait dinners were held in the last century.
- ③ Goldharbour. A fascinating row of old riverside houses.
- ④ 'Environmental Impact Scheme' by Docklands Development Corporation.
- ⑤ Unusual 'Art and Sculpture Casting Factory' where the Spratts' Mills once stood.
- ⑥ Limehouse Cut. Built in 1770.
- ⑦ St. Anne's Limehouse. Designed by Nicholas Hawksmoor and built 1712-1730. Next to it is Limehouse Town Hall, built in 1879.
- ⑧ Commercial Road & East India Dock Road were built by the East India Company between 1803 and 1810 to join its new docks to the City.
- ⑨ The Grand Union Canal (which runs to Birmingham and the Regents Canal Dock) were built between 1812 and 1820.
- ⑩ St. Paul's Shadwell. Designed by John Wallis and built 1817-1821. A 'Waterloo' Church built after the Battle, out of £1 million collected as a thank-offering for a victory. The earlier chapel built in 1669 was the 'Church of the Sea Captains'.
- ⑪ St. George's-in-the-Field. Hawksmoor, 1715-1723. Interior destroyed.
