This year the EUTP Walk is in the "Inner Inner City"! You can't get any further in than a walk which takes in Kings Cross, London Wall, St. Pauls and crosses the river to Waterloo. From my point of view, most of the walk is "across the water" - when I first came to live in South London, I thought that meant New York - not just the Thames! More than any other walk that we have done, it takes in places of enormous historic interest, both famous and notorious.

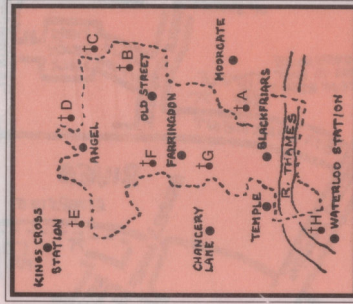
At the same time people live in the places where we will be walking. While we pass the centres of the great financial and commercial powers of the nation, and it's law courts, cheek-by-jowl we will pass the homes of some of the poorest as well as the wealthiest of the

people in this country. Six inner-London boroughs show the biggest increase in conditions of deprivation of anywhere in the country over the last 10 years. EUTP walkers can reflect on the extremes they see around them, symptomatic of what is happening to a whole society, and remember the words of the psalmist "Righteousness exalts a nation".

EUTP intends to stay with Christian groups who worship, live and work at the bottom of the urban heap. Walk well.

Basil Cracknell Writes...

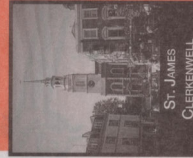
Dear Walkers,

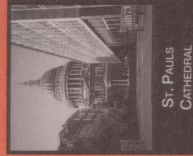

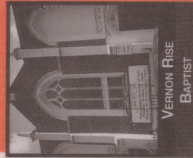
