



COULD YOUR CHURCH HELP SUPPORT UNLOCK?


Most Churches give a percentage of their regular income to support Christian charities, both overseas and in the UK, especially those working in Christian Mission. In this way they contribute to the work of God's Kingdom beyond their own neighbourhood. Some give their whole contribution to one charity, others support a range of different concerns. Some review their commitments annually, others make longer term commitments.

If your church does not already do this, then maybe you could ask them to consider it. If they do already give in this way then how about proposing that they support Unlock the next time they review their current giving.

Unlock relies almost entirely on voluntary gifts to enable us to do our work developing urban discipleship and Unlocking Life, in the deprived parts of urban Britain.

A regular commitment from a handful of churches would free us from the constant pressure of seeking funding, and allow us to focus our energy and resources on our frontline work in UK cities.

With almost 50 years of experience and expertise, we train, pay, and resource workers in city locations, we offer our insights and experience to others working in urban mission, we make resources available free of charge to anyone who wants to use them in their work of developing discipleship.
