Q. How many creatures does the playground mural suggest might be seen around here?
A. 30 (Note: there is another mural nearby with about 125 creatures but it's not at the playground)

L. On righthandmost of 4 information boards on e side of church building
Q. How much did it cost to build this church 200 years ago?
A. £15,274

Q. What must we develop here in order to carry a positive action?
A. A positive vision

Q. How old are Vauxhall Pleasure Gardens?
A. 1661 or 364 years

Q. Name 3 of the 9 experiences this riverside site has gone through
A. Worshipped, feared, respected, worked, abused, traversed, ignored, restored, enjoyed
(Note: There are also 8 pictures of various activities on the board, which is why the number "9" is specifically included in the question.)

Q. What is in/below this building?
A. Heathwall Sewage Pumping Station
(Note: the board with the answer has been removed. The answer is also on a gate to the premises, but that is quite difficult to spot.)

b) What is the title of David Waterhouse's "David & Goliath" story?
A. a) 1950s b) A Houseboat on the Thames (Note: this information panel has vanished.)

A. Carey Gardens Community

A. A butterfly

A. June

Q. a) What human rights anti-poverty organisation can be found at 48 Addington Square?
b) Which founder of the National Trust was born in Addington Square?
A. a) ATD Fourth World b) Robert Hunter

L. Camberwell Rd. e side, opposite Methodist Church
Q. When was the school uniform shop at 77 Camberwell Road established?
A. 1883

L. nw side Grosvenor Terrace $\frac{1}{4}$ way down

Q. What lies between Numbers 64 & 66 on Grosvenor Terrace?
A. John Ruskin Primary School entrances for boys and girls & infants
