

This year's walk moves back south of the river for most of it. We broke all records in 1996 in sponsor money, and hope to do so again, as Eutp depends on that support to continue it's work.

The '97 walk reveals the nature of much of inner London as a series of "urban villages" - "We live in Angell town" - "Oh, you mean Brixton?" - "No Angell town!"
